MS: Corporal Michael Segreaves, Orange County Sheriff's Office. Today's date, July 22, 2008. The time is 1843 hours. I am currently [REDACTED] That's [REDACTED] Uhm, present with me is Detective Tom Manderville, and I am present with Brittany Schieber. Is that correct?

BS: Uh-hum (affirmative).

MS: Brittany, can you spell your first and last name for me?

BS: B-R-I-T-T-A-N-Y, and my last name is S-C-H-I-E-B-E-R.

MS: And your date of birth?

BS: [REDACTED]

MS: Okay. Uhm, as you know I'm out here following up on the uh, Caylee Anthony uh, case right now. I'm doing some follow up work.

BS: Uh-hum (affirmative).

MS: And talking to you you told me that you, you know Casey Anthony.

BS: Right.

MS: Is that correct?

BS: Yes.

MS: How long have you known Casey?

BS: Since I was about five.

MS: Okay.

BS: Uh.

MS: And how old are you now?

BS: Twenty-two.

MS: Twenty-two?

BS: (Chuckles.)

MS: Uhm, what can you tell me about Casey?

BS: From what I've known she's always been a kind hearted person to be honest with you. Uhm, like I said, I haven't kept up with her since high school much because we kind of went our separate ways, but we've been in contact.

MS: What year, what year did you graduate high school?

BS: 2004.

MS: Okay. So after 2004, or after graduation in 2004 you kind of lost contact with her?

BS: Well, I mean we either, we could always have contact. We live right down the street. But we both have two separate lives.

MS: Okay.

BS: So....

MS: So you weren't like real tight hanging out....

BS: No.

MS: ...hanging out with her?

BS: No.

MS: Okay. Now, you told me you received some e-mails from her via My Space...

BS: Correct.

MS: ...back in June?

BS: Yes.

MS: Do you know what day that was?

BS: It started June 9th.

MS: And...

BS: And continued until about the 25th.

MS: Okay. What, what did those e-mails consist of?

BS: Asking me if I wanted to go out to the clubs with her, uhm, to get some girls together to hang out at the night club. Club Fusion is the main one.

MS: Okay. So that was like most of the e-mails and that started on June 9th?

BS: That was what all the e-mails consisted of was wanting to go to the club and getting girls together to go to the club.

MS: Okay. What's your My Space i.d. (identification), or whatever you use. I don't know much about My Space to be honest with you.

BS: Uh, oh, I don't even, I couldn't even tell you...

MS: Uh-hum (affirmative).

BS: ...to be honest, huh.

MS: Alright. Do you still have those messages saved?

BS: Yes, I do.

MS: Okay. Uhm, did she ever mention in any, any of the e-mail messages on My Space about her baby being missing?

BS: No sir.

MS: Never?

BS: Never.

MS: Okay. Now you also told me you received some text messages on your phone.

BS: Yes.

MS: And what's your phone number?

BS: [REDACTED]

MS: And who's your carrier?

BS: T-Mobile.

MS: Okay. What was the uhm, what can you tell me about the text messages?

BS: Uhm, (sighs), just that I woke up to a text message and when I looked....

MS: When was that?

BS: I'm sorry?

MS: What date was that?

BS: July 16th.

MS: July 16th? And what did that text message say?

BS: Uhm, it says, "Caylee is missing. She has been for thirty-two days now. Please, if you have any information call me on cell or at home."

MS: What time did you receive that text?

BS: 9:42 am.

MS: Okay. Did you respond to it?

BS: Yes. I asked her, I wrote down Caylee is missing with a question mark because I really couldn't believe it. And she responded to me.

MS: So you typed her back, "Caylee is missing, question mark?"

BS: Caylee, yes.

MS: And what'd she respond back?

BS: "Yes, she has been for a few weeks."

MS: Okay. Did you have any other messages from her that day, or afterwards, or?

BS: Uhm, she just told me, it says in, I believe I asked her from who, or oh, I asked her what happened and she said that it was from the nanny. Someone she trusted.

MS: Now you're reading that right off of your....

BS: Uhm, it says, "Her nanny. Someone I trusted I took her. No calls until
yesterday."

MS: And what date and time is that?

BS: That was the 16th also, July 16th, at 11:30am

MS: Okay. Any other messages or ex...

BS: And I asked her, I told her I was sorry for everything that and if she needed anything to let me know. She told me thank you. And I asked her if there was anything I should keep my eye open to to watch out for and she responded with, "A silver Ford Focus, four-door."

MS: Okay. Did you have, did you talk to her on the phone that day or anything?

BS: No sir.

MS: Have you talked to on the phone since?

BS: No.

MS: Any e-mail messages since then or?

BS: Not sin...the last one I received from her was June 25th.

MS: And again, well was that just in reference to going out to clubs....

BS: Yeah (affirmative).

MS: ...or anything?

BS: Uh-hum (affirmative).

MS: Okay. And would you be willing to, you know, maybe try and help us out and print those e-mail messages....

BS: Yeah (affirmative).

MS: ...or....

BS: No problem.

MS: ...show us them or somehow?

BS: No problem.

MS: The same with the phone, if you wouldn't mind.

BS: Yes sir, no problem.

MS: Uhm, when was the last time you remember seeing Caylee?

BS: Uhm, I'm barely ever home because I work all the time. But I've seen Caylee outside a couple of times, but only with her grandparents. I've never seen Casey have Caylee playing outside or in the front yard or anything. Because that's where I'm usually out with my son is the front yard, so. And I know, but I know they have stuff in the backyard for her, so she could have been there. But with Casey

it's been a while to be honest. Because like I said, she supposedly worked during the day and then I work at night. So when she's, when she was supposedly coming I was going. So it's....

MS: Okay. Did you, and any reference to going out to those clubs in those e-mail messages did you, did you ever to out with her?

BS: No.

MS: So from that first, you know, e-mail that you're talking about, June 9th until July 16th it was, or....

BS: Uh-hum (affirmative).

MS: ...or thereafter, you, you didn't go out with her, or didn't...

BS: No sir.

MS: Okay. Hang on. Do you have anything else you can think of?

BS: No...

MS: She never mentioned....

BS: ...to be honest...

MS: ...mentioned any other thing about the baby to you? Did you see anybody with the baby?

BS: No.

MS: No? Okay. Can you raise your right hand for me? Do you swear and/or affirm that everything you told me today is the truth and nothing but the truth?

BS: Yes sir.

MS: Okay. I'm going to go ahead and conclude this interview at 1850 hours.
